



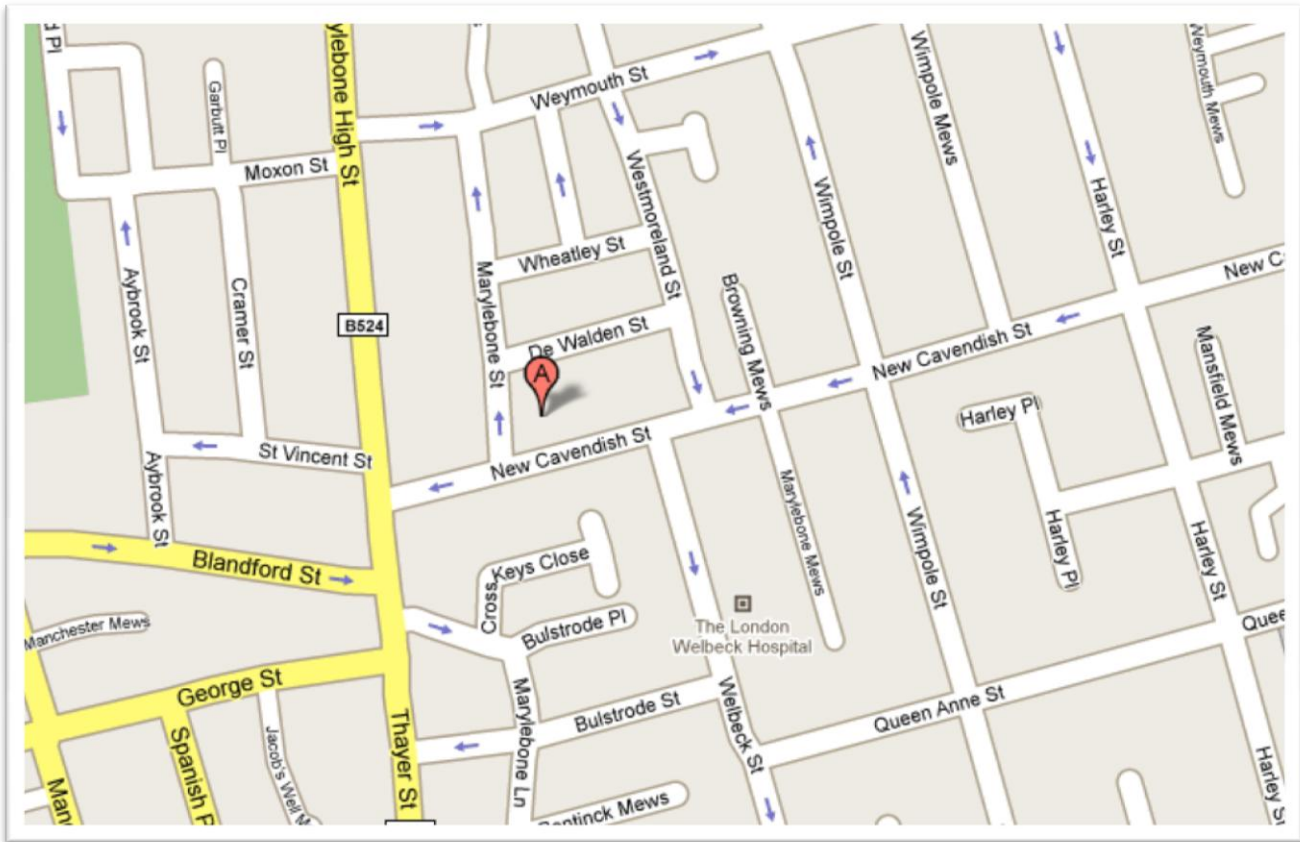

Parking methods in Westminster

Telephone

The number to call for this procedure is 0870 428 4009 which is found on the sign post next to the parking bay.

The automated service will require your location, which is also marked on the signpost as “quote location” followed by a four digit number which you must dictate or tap into your mobile phone.

The same applies to your vehicle registration number.

Lastly you must also include the amount of minutes you wish to stay in your allocated parking bay.

Your mobile number acts as an account number. Thus the next time you park using this method, you will only need to state the above details without having to re-register all your details again.

Text

The number to call for this service is 07950 008 0201. This saves you from having to listen to an automated service, which may be challenging if you have difficulties using the telephone.

Internet

You can register all your vehicle's details on the following website: www.westminster.gov.uk, then go to the "parking" tab for instructions.

Pay & Display (£1.30/hour)

These meters can be found in the following locations:

- Harley Street (just past Queen Anne Street)
- Weymouth Mews
- Clipstone Mews (next to the University of Westminster)

Car Parks

The nearest car parks are located in the following streets:

- Chiltern Street (£4,50 per hour; £8 for 2hours)
- Harley Street (£5,00 per hour; £8.50 for 2hours)
- Cramer Street (£5.00/h; £9.00 for 2hours)

Public Transport

The nearest underground stations to Cubex are: Bond Street (Central and Jubilee line) and Baker Street (Hammersmith & City, Circle, Metropolitan, Jubilee and Bakerloo line)

***The Blue Badge Scheme**

This scheme is available to those of our clients whom are disabled in some form i.e. if you are unable to walk or if you have a physical disability which causes great discomfort when walking a short distance. This scheme is also available to you if you have a war pensioners mobility supplement.

However there are other forms of disabilities which may entitle you to a blue badge.

The blue badge scheme would allow you to park for a minimum fee in Westminster and allows you an extra hour of free parking. It is completely free to park in certain boroughs

In order to find out more about whether you are eligible for a blue badge you need to apply to your local authority or go to the website www.direct.gov.uk and click on "find your local council".
